



MSLPAC COVID Safety Protocols for Public Events

as of May 18th, 2022

As part of Main Street Landing, the Performing Arts Center follows guidelines to ensure the safety of our tenants, as well as our patrons. In addition, we have added safety guidelines based on industry/live performance practices which in turn are based on the current science and data and are therefore subject to change. Please make sure you are comfortable with these requirements before renting space or attending events at Main Street Landing.

- Face covering for event attendees is required for attendance and must be worn at all times inside the building. Performers or presenters may unmask while performing or speaking, but need to re-mask in common areas of the building (ex. hallways, bathrooms).
- Proof of vaccination or a negative result from a COVID-19 test administered no more than 72 hours before the event is expected of all visitors, volunteers, and staff at events.
- All spaces are only to be used at a reduced capacity so that social distancing can be practiced and maintained.
- Hand sanitizer stations are conveniently located in multiple locations throughout the facility.
- All Main Street Landing buildings and bathrooms are frequently cleaned and sanitized by professional staff.
- The Performing Arts Center office will be open, but only meeting with clients who schedule directly with our office and follow all COVID related protocols.
